The Hyattstown Mill Arts Project is celebrating its 20th anniversary with an art exhibit entitled “**Return to Sugarloaf.**” Twenty years ago, our very first show also highlighted this beautiful mountain. We welcome your art submissions—painting, drawing, sculpture (including outdoor sculpture)—on the theme of Sugarloaf Mountain.

KEY DATES

Saturday, June 22, 10 am to 1 pm: Drop off one piece of art at the mill and fill out the information form. We will also have a sign-up list for volunteers to sit the mill during open hours.

- Members free, non-members \$10. We encourage you to join our community of artists, writers, and musicians.
- Painting limited to 3 feet by 4 feet.
- Place your name/name of piece on the back of the artwork.
- HMAP will retain a 20% commission on any art that is sold.

Saturday, June 29, 2 pm to 4 pm: Opening artists’ reception

Saturday June 29 – Sunday, June 30, 10 am to 4 pm: Montgomery Heritage Days activities at the mill. In addition to the art exhibit, HMAP will feature art for children and live music.

Saturday, August 3, 10 am to 1 pm: Pick up artwork.

The exhibit will run on weekends, 10 am – 4 pm from Saturday, June 29th through Sunday, July 28th

The opening artists’ reception on Saturday June 29 coincides with **Montgomery Heritage Days** weekend (Saturday and Sunday, June 29 and 30). On both days, HMAP will offer art for children from 10 am to 4 pm and live music from 3:00 to 4:30.
